In December 2025, we made history by performing the first-ever Nativity Musical in an African language on British soil! Tàn Mólẹ̀ was founded in October 2025 by Samuel Jonathan, a musician, percussionist, composer, playwright and actor, whose journey with music started in 1974.

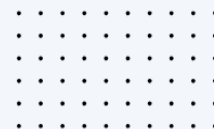
